SUMMER CAMP POLICIES

HOURS

- All camps are from 9am-4pm.
- Drop off opens at 8am (no early fee)
- Pick up is from 3:45-4pm
- Extended pick up hours are available (4-6pm)- \$10/day

A payment method must be on the student's account to utilize extended hours.

SPACE AND ATTENDANCE

- Space is limited; register online early to secure space.
- All campers must have already completed Kindergarten, entering at least 1st grade.
- Attendance capacity is based on the needs of the camp program itself and cannot be adjusted due to late registration, buddy expectations, etc.
- Requests to make changes from one camp session to another must be sent to SongbirdsOviedo@gmail.com at least four weeks prior to the start of the originally scheduled camp session. One change request per camper will be accepted free of charge, and additional changes will incur a \$20 fee.

DRESS CODE

- Campers should dress appropriately for the activities scheduled. We recommend shorts and a light weight shirt or top, and some type of athletic shoe or sneaker in order to participate in all activities.
- Sandals, flip-flops, rubber "crocs"-style shoes, and other open-toed shoes are not recommended.
- *We utilize Acrylic paints that <u>do not</u> come out of clothing.

LUNCH/SNACKS

- Campers must bring a lunch, two snacks, and a drink in a non-glass container.
- Snacks should be in a paper, plastic, or reusable bag clearly labeled with the child's name.
- Please do not send gum or anything high in sugar.
- Children are not permitted to "trade" their food.
- A microwave is available for use.

MEDIA

- We utilize the app "Band" to share our photos with parents. A link to each week's band will be sent out in the prior week.
- If your student is not able to be photographed, please send an email to us. Please include an image of their face so if they accidentally end up in a photo we can easily delete it before sharing with other parents.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

- Please put the camper's name on all articles of clothing, snack bags, bags, etc.
- Campers should not bring toys, mobile phones, electronic devices, jewelry, money, Pokémon cards, or any possession of value with them to any of the programs.
- Campers will be <u>entirely</u> responsible for their belongings. Songbirds is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal items.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT

- A **\$50 NON REFUNDABLE** deposit is required for each camp you wish to attend.
- Payment is due in full four weeks prior to the camp start date. If you have a credit card on file, payment will be processed four weeks prior to the camp's start date. If paying by check or cash and full payment is not received four weeks prior to your camper's start date, your slot will be forfeited and opened up to other campers. Your deposit will not be refunded.
- All credit card purchases are subject to a 3% fee. If you are using a debit card, please call the studio to make payment.
- Payment for Extended Hours will be processed at the end of each day. A payment method must be on the student's account to utilize extended hours.

REFUNDS

- Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing to <u>admin@songbirdsoviedo.com</u> at least four weeks in advance of the camp start date for consideration (include the subject heading: Camp Refund).
- Refunds for cancellations occurring less than four weeks in advance are only considered in cases of emergency and handled on a case-by-case basis.
 These requests must be submitted within seven days of the camp start date. Deposits are non-refundable.
- Refunds are NOT issued for early departures from camp, campers considered "no shows" (those who do not attend and did not give advance notification of cancellation), for any illness, or for days missed during.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Illness: Campers who show signs of being visibly ill, will be sent home. Campers must be symptom-free for at least 24 hours before returning
- **Lice**: If a camper is found to have lice or nits, they will need to be picked up immediately and may not return to camp until they are completely lice and nit free.
- Medical: Basic first aid will be administered for minor injuries, and parents/guardians will be notified. For emergencies, medical services will be contacted, and parents/guardians will be informed immediately.
- Medication: If your child requires medication during camp hours, please given them to the camp staff upon arrival and ensure they are clearly labeled with the child's name and relevant directions.
- Allergies: Parents must inform staff of any allergies (food, environmental, etc.) prior to the start of camp. Please ensure your child's emergency medication (e.g., EpiPen) is provided if needed. We strive to accommodate allergies but cannot guarantee a completely allergen-free environment.
- Behavior: Campers are expected to follow safety rules and behave respectfully toward peers and staff.
 Repeated unsafe or disruptive behavior may result in dismissal from camp without a refund.
